Mr. STOCKMAN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the
Committee on Science, Space, and Technology

A BILL

To study the effect of the Earth’s magnetic field on the
weather.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stockman Effect Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. MAGNETIC FIELD STUDY.**

6 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds as follows:

7 (1) Prior to a magnetic polar shift, there is a
8 decline in the Earth’s magnetic fields.

9 (2) Decrease in magnetic fields could impact
10 global temperatures.

1 (3) There is a possibility that the reason Mars
2 lost its atmosphere was because of the loss of its
3 magnetic field.

4 (b) MAGNETIC FIELD STUDY.—The director of the
5 National Science Foundation shall commission a study on
6 the impact that a shift in the Earth's magnetic field could
7 have on the weather.
