## A BILL

To release the reversionary interest of the United States in certain non-Federal land in Salt Lake City, Utah, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “University of Utah  
5 Research Park Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. RELEASE OF REVERSIONARY INTEREST OF THE**  
7 **UNITED STATES IN NON-FEDERAL LAND IN**  
8 **SALT LAKE CITY, UTAH.**

9 (a) RELEASE.—There is released to the University of  
10 Utah, without consideration, the reversionary interest of

1 the United States in the non-Federal land described in  
2 subsection (b).

3 (b) DESCRIPTION OF NON-FEDERAL LAND.—The  
4 non-Federal land referred to in subsection (a) is the ap-  
5 proximately 593 acres of land of the University of Utah—

6 (1) identified in the patent—

7 (A) numbered 43-99-0012; and

8 (B) dated October 18, 1968; and

9 (2) more particularly described as tracts D (ex-  
10 cluding the parcels numbered 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5), G,  
11 and J, T. 1 S., R. 1 E., Salt Lake Meridian.
