3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Disaster Assistance
5 Recoupment Fairness Act of 2014”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF WAIVER AUTHORITY.**

3 dated Appropriations Act, 2012 (125 Stat. 982; also
4 known as the “Disaster Assistance Recoupment Fairness
5 Act of 2011”) is amended in subsection (b)(1)(B) by strik-
6 ing “December 31, 2010” and inserting “December 31,
7 2014”.
