3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Technology for Energy
5 Security Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF ENERGY CREDIT FOR QUALIFIED**
2 **FUEL CELL PROPERTY.**

3 Section 48(c)(1)(E) of the Internal Revenue Code of
4 1986 is amended by striking “January 1, 2025” and in-
5 serting “January 1, 2033”.

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
