5 The Public Health Service Act is amended by insert6 ing after section 319C-2 of such Act (42 U.S.C. 247d7 3b) the following new section:

8 "SEC. 319C-3. IMPROVING THE PREPAREDNESS OF NURS9 ING HOMES, ASSISTED LIVING FACILITIES,
10 AND OTHER LONG-TERM CARE FACILITIES
11 FOR POWER OUTAGES.

12 "(a) GRANTS.—The Secretary may award grants to 13 nursing homes, assisted living facilities, and other long-14 term care facilities to improve their preparedness for 15 power outages, including during and after a natural dis-16 aster.

"(b) USE OF FUNDS.—The preparedness activities
funded through a grant under this section may include—
"(1) the purchase of a backup power source,
such as a generator, and any related equipment; and
"(2) the creation of a regional resource directory on disaster and post-disaster preparedness for
power outages.

24 "(c) PREFERENCE.—In awarding grants under this25 section, the Secretary shall give preference to nursing

homes, assisted living facilities, and other long-term care 1 2 facilities that— 3 "(1) are located in areas that— "(A) have a high proportion of— 4 "(i) elderly residents; or 5 "(ii) individuals who are enrolled in a 6 7 State plan under title XIX of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.) (or 8 under a waiver of such plan); and 9 "(B) have a high risk of hurricanes or 10 11 other natural disasters; and "(2) have not been cited for a substantive Fed-12 13 eral, State, or local violation. 14 "(d) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.-To 15 carry out this section, there are authorized to be appro-16 priated such sums as may be necessary.".

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
