A BILL

To extend reemployment services and eligibility assessments to all claimants for unemployment benefits, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Building on Reemploy-*
5 *ment Improvements to Deliver Good Employment for Work-*
6 *ers Act” or the “BRIDGE for Workers Act”.*

7 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR REEMPLOYMENT SERVICES.**

8 *(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 306(a) of the Social Secu-*
9 *rity Act (42 U.S.C. 506(a)) is amended—*

10 *(1) by striking “individuals referred to reem-*
11 *ployment services as described in section 303(j)” and*
12 *inserting “claimants for regular compensation, in-*
13 *cluding claimants referred to reemployment services*
14 *as described in section 303(j),”;* and

15 *(2) by striking “such individuals” and inserting*
16 *“such claimants”.*

17 *(b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by sub-*
18 *section (a) shall take effect on the date of enactment of this*
19 *Act.*
