1 "(1) IN GENERAL.—The Commissioner of U.S. 2 Customs and Border Protection may, subject to sub-3 section (b), consolidate, modify, or reorganize cus-4 toms revenue functions delegated to the Commis-5 sioner under subsection (a), including by adding 6 such functions to existing positions or establishing 7 new or modifying existing job series, grades, titles, 8 or classifications for personnel, and associated sup-9 port staff, performing such functions, in consultation 10 with the Office of Personnel Management.

"(2) POSITION CLASSIFICATION STANDARDS.—
At the request of the Commissioner, the Director of
the Office of Personnel Management shall establish
new position classification standards for any new positions established by the Commissioner under paragraph (1).".
