1 **SECTION 1. REPEAL OF SEPARATE CONTRIBUTION LIMITS**
2 **FOR CERTAIN CONTRIBUTIONS MADE TO NA-**
3 **TIONAL COMMITTEES OF POLITICAL PAR-**
4 **TIES.**

5 (a) REPEAL.—Section 101 of the Consolidated and
6 Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2015 is repealed,
7 and any provision of law amended by such section shall
8 be restored as if such section had not been enacted into
9 law.

10 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
11 subsection (a) shall take effect as if included in the enact-
12 ment of the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appro-
13 priations Act, 2015.
