"(I) is an officer or employee of 1 2 the Postal Service who— "(aa) is not represented by a 3 bargaining representative recog-4 nized under section 1203; and 5 "(bb) is in a supervisory, 6 professional, technical, clerical, 7 administrative, or managerial po-8 9 sition covered by the Executive and Administrative Schedule; 10 and". 11
