1SECTION 1. CONGRESSIONAL NOTIFICATION REQUIRE-2MENTS.

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
4 (b) or as expressly provided in another provision of law,
5 the Secretary of Transportation shall provide to the appro6 priate committees of Congress notice of an announcement
7 concerning a covered project at least 3 full business days
8 before the announcement is made by the Department of
9 Transportation.

10 (b) EMERGENCY PROGRAM.—With respect to an allo-11 cation of funds under section 125 of title 23, United 12 States Code, the Secretary shall provide to the Committee 13 on Transportation and Infrastructure of the House of 14 Representatives and the Committee on Environment and 15 Public Works of the Senate notice of the allocation—

- 16 (1) at least 3 full business days before the17 issuance of the allocation; or
- (2) concurrently with the issuance of the allocation, if the allocation is made using the quick release
 process of the Department (or any successor process).

22 SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.

23 In this Act, the following definitions apply:

24 (1) APPROPRIATE COMMITTEES OF CON25 GRESS.—The term "appropriate committees of Con26 gress" means—

1(A) the Committee on Transportation and2Infrastructure of the House of Representatives;3and

4 (B) the Committee on Environment and
5 Public Works, the Committee on Commerce,
6 Science, and Transportation, and the Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs
8 of the Senate.

9 (2) COVERED PROJECT.—The term "covered 10 project" means a project competitively selected by 11 the Department of Transportation to receive a dis-12 cretionary grant award, letter of intent, loan com-13 mitment, loan guarantee commitment, or line of 14 credit commitment in an amount equal to or greater 15 than \$750,000.

16 (3) DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION.—The
17 term "Department of Transportation" includes the
18 modal administrations of the Department of Trans19 portation.
