A BILL

To amend the State Department Basic Authorities Act of 1956 to eliminate the repatriation loan program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Leave No Americans
5 Behind Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF REPATRIATION LOANS BY DE-**
7 **PARTMENT OF STATE.**

8 Section 4 of the State Department Basic Authorities
9 Act of 1956 (22 U.S.C. 2671) is amended—

1 (1) in subsection (b)(2)(A)(ii), by striking “, on
2 a reimbursable basis to the maximum extent prac-
3 ticable, with such reimbursements to be credited to
4 the applicable Department of State appropriation
5 and to remain available until expended, except that
6 no reimbursement under this clause shall be paid
7 that is greater than the amount the person evacu-
8 ated would have been charged for a reasonable com-
9 mercial air fare immediately prior to the events giv-
10 ing rise to the evacuation”; and

11 (2) by striking subsection (d).
