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## A BILL

To prohibit funding to implement any provision of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act or of the health-related provisions of the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NObamacare Funds  
5 Act of 2012”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING FUNDING TO IMPLEMENT PUBLIC**  
2 **LAW 111-148 OR THE HEALTH-RELATED PRO-**  
3 **VISIONS OF PUBLIC LAW 111-152.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, on and  
5 after the date of the enactment of this Act, no funds may  
6 be obligated or expended to carry out—

7 (1) any provision of the Patient Protection and  
8 Affordable Care Act (Public Law 111-148), includ-  
9 ing any amendment made by any such provision; or

10 (2) any provision of title I or subtitle B of title  
11 II of the Health Care and Education Reconciliation  
12 Act of 2010 (Public Law 111-152), including any  
13 amendment made by any such provision.

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
