A BILL

To prohibit the use of Federal funds to study, propose, establish, implement, or enforce any mileage tax, including through the funding of a mileage tracking program.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Track No Tax Act
5 of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON USE OF FEDERAL FUNDS FOR IM-**
2 **PLEMENTATION OF MILEAGE TAXES.**

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no Fed-
4 eral funds may be obligated or expended, directly or indi-
5 rectly, to study, propose, establish, implement, or enforce
6 any State, local, or Federal mileage tax, including through
7 the funding of a mileage tracking program.
