## A BILL

To amend the FAA Reauthorization Act of 2018 to extend waiver of duplicate benefits limitation for certain payments to individuals in the event of a major disaster, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Duplications of Bene-  
5 fits Victims Relief Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. WAIVER OF DUPLICATE BENEFITS.**

7 Section 1210(a) of the FAA Reauthorization Act of  
8 2018 (Public Law 115–254) is amended—

1           (1) in paragraph (3) by striking “between Jan-  
2           uary 1, 2016, and December 31, 2021” and insert-  
3           ing “during the period beginning on January 1,  
4           2016, and ending on the date on which the provision  
5           contained in such amendment is struck pursuant to  
6           paragraph (4)”;

7           (2) in paragraph (4) by striking “5” and insert-  
8           ing “10”;

9           (3) by redesignating paragraph (5) as para-  
10          graph (6); and

11          (4) by inserting after paragraph (4) the fol-  
12          lowing:

13                 “(5) PROHIBITION ON INCOME THRESHOLD.—  
14                 In carrying out the amendment made by paragraph  
15                 (1), no income threshold may be applied to limit the  
16                 eligibility of a recipient from qualifying for a waiver  
17                 under the amendment made by such paragraph.”.
