## A BILL

To prohibit funding for the United Nations Human Rights  
Council until it condemns Hamas.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stand with Israel Act”.

5 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON FUNDS FOR THE UNITED NATIONS**

6 **HUMAN RIGHTS COUNCIL.**

7 (a) FINDING.—Congress finds that Hamas, Iranian  
8 backed terrorists, on October 7, 2023, launched a massive,

1 unprovoked war on Israel by firing thousands of rockets,  
2 gunmen storming Israeli homes killing whoever they could  
3 find, resulting in the death and abduction of countless  
4 Israeli and American civilians.

5 (b) PROHIBITION.—No Federal funds may be obli-  
6 gated or expended to provide assessed or voluntary con-  
7 tributions or any other funding to the United Nations  
8 Human Rights Council until the United Nations Security  
9 Council and United Nations General Assembly adopts a  
10 resolution to condemn Hamas relating to its actions de-  
11 scribed in subsection (a).
