A BILL

To provide clarity on the use of National Infantry Museum and Soldier Center Commemorative Coin surcharges, the use of Abraham Lincoln Commemorative Coin surcharges, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL INFANTRY MUSEUM AND SOLDIER**
4 **CENTER COMMEMORATIVE COIN SUR-**
5 **CHARGES.**

6 Section 6(b) of the National Infantry Museum and
7 Soldier Center Commemorative Coin Act (Public Law
8 110–357, 122 Stat. 3999) is amended by inserting before

1 the period at the end the following: “, and for the retire-
2 ment of debt associated with building the existing Na-
3 tional Infantry Museum and Soldier Center”.

4 **SEC. 2. ABRAHAM LINCOLN COMMEMORATIVE COIN SUR-**
5 **CHARGES.**

6 Section 7(b) of the Abraham Lincoln Commemorative
7 Coin Act (Public Law 109–285, 120 Stat. 1215) is
8 amended by striking “Secretary to” and all that follows
9 through the end of the subsection and inserting the fol-
10 lowing:

11 “Secretary as follows:

12 “(1) Forty percent, to the Abraham Lincoln Bi-
13 centennial foundation, to further its work.

14 “(2) Twenty percent each, to the Ford’s The-
15 ater Society, the National Trust for Historic Preser-
16 vation President Lincoln’s Cottage fund, and the
17 Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum,
18 for the preservation and maintenance of their build-
19 ings and the contents of their buildings.”.
