A BILL

To reaffirm that certain land has been taken into trust for the benefit of the Samish Indian Nation, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SEC. 1. REAFFIRMATION OF LAW.**

4 *The applicability of the Act of June 18, 1934 (25*
5 *U.S.C. 5101 et seq.; 48 Stat. 984, chapter 576) (commonly*
6 *known as the “Indian Reorganization Act”) is reaffirmed*
7 *for the Samish Indian Nation.*

8 **SEC. 2. NO IMPACT ON TREATY RIGHTS.**

9 *Nothing in this Act shall be interpreted as affecting*
10 *treaty rights under the Treaty of Point Elliott.*

Amend the title so as to read: “A bill to reaffirm the applicability of the Act of June 18, 1934, to the Samish Indian Nation, and for other purposes.”.
