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# A BILL

To extend the National Alzheimer's Project.

1        *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4        *This Act may be cited as the “NAPA Reauthorization*  
5 *Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF NATIONAL ALZHEIMER’S PROJECT.**

7        (a) *PURPOSE OF PROJECT.*—*Section 2(c) of the Na-*  
8 *tional Alzheimer’s Project Act (42 U.S.C. 11225(c)) is*  
9 *amended—*

10            (1) *in paragraph (2), by striking “and coordina-*  
11 *tion of” and inserting “on, and coordination of,”;*

12            (2) *in paragraph (4)—*

13                    (A) *by redesignating subparagraphs (A)*  
14 *and (B) as subparagraphs (B) and (C), respec-*  
15 *tively; and*

16                    (B) *by inserting before subparagraph (B),*  
17 *as so redesignated, the following:*

18                            *“(A) promotion of healthy aging and reduc-*  
19 *tion and mitigation of risk factors for Alz-*  
20 *heimer’s;”;*

21            (3) *in paragraph (5)—*

22                    (A) *by inserting “and other underserved*  
23 *populations, including individuals with develop-*  
24 *mental disabilities such as Down syndrome,”*  
25 *after “populations”; and*

1                   (B) by striking “; and” and inserting a  
2                   semicolon;

3                   (4) by redesignating paragraph (6) as para-  
4                   graph (7); and

5                   (5) by inserting after paragraph (5) the fol-  
6                   lowing:

7                   “(6) provide information on, and promote the  
8                   adoption of, healthy behaviors that may reduce the  
9                   risk of cognitive decline and promote and protect cog-  
10                  nitive health; and”.

11                  (b) NATIONAL PLAN.—Section 2(d)(2) of the National  
12                  Alzheimer’s Project Act (42 U.S.C. 11225(d)(2)) is amend-  
13                  ed—

14                   (1) by inserting “, across public and private sec-  
15                   tors,” after “Nation’s progress”; and

16                   (2) by inserting “, including consideration of  
17                   public-private collaborations, as appropriate” before  
18                   the period at the end.

19                  (c) ADVISORY COUNCIL.—Section 2(e) of the National  
20                  Alzheimer’s Project Act (42 U.S.C. 11225(e)) is amended—

21                   (1) in paragraph (2)—

22                   (A) in subparagraph (A), by adding at the  
23                   end the following:

24                   “(xi) A designee of the Department of  
25                   Justice.

1                   “(xii) A designee of the Social Security  
2                   Administration.

3                   “(xiii) A designee of the Federal Emer-  
4                   gency Management Agency.

5                   “(xiv) 2 or more other designees of the  
6                   Department of Health and Human Services,  
7                   at least one of whom has expertise in risk  
8                   factors associated with the development or  
9                   the progression of Alzheimer’s disease, as de-  
10                  termined by the Secretary of Health and  
11                  Human Services.”; and

12                  (B) in subparagraph (B)—

13                   (i) in the matter preceding clause (i),  
14                   by striking “12” and inserting “14”;

15                   (ii) in clause (v)—

16                           (I) by striking “2 researchers”  
17                           and inserting “3 researchers”; and

18                           (II) by striking “; and” and in-  
19                           serting “, including at least one re-  
20                           searcher with demonstrated experience  
21                           in recruitment and retention of under-  
22                           represented groups into research or  
23                           clinical trials related to dementia;”;

24                   (iii) in clause (vi), by striking the pe-  
25                   riod at the end and inserting “; and”; and

1                   (iv) by adding at the end the following:

2                   “(vii) 1 individual with a diagnosis of  
3                   Alzheimer’s disease.”;

4           (2) in paragraph (5)—

5                   (A) in subparagraph (A)—

6                           (i) by striking “an initial evaluation”  
7                           and inserting “annual evaluations”; and

8                           (ii) by striking “research, clinical”  
9                           and inserting “research, risk reduction,  
10                           public health, clinical”;

11                   (B) in subparagraph (B), by striking “ini-  
12                   tial” and inserting “annual”;

13                   (C) in subparagraph (C)—

14                           (i) in the matter preceding clause (i),  
15                           by striking “initial” and inserting “an-  
16                           nual”; and

17                           (ii) in clause (ii), by inserting “and  
18                           reduce disparities” before the semicolon at  
19                           the end; and

20                   (D) in subparagraph (D), by striking “an-  
21                   nually thereafter, an evaluation” and inserting  
22                   “annual evaluations”; and

23           (3) in paragraph (6), by striking “2025” and in-  
24           serting “2035”.

1           (d) *ANNUAL REPORT*.—Section 2(g) of the National  
2 *Alzheimer’s Project Act* (42 U.S.C. 11225(g)) is amended—

3           (1) in paragraph (1)—

4           (A) by striking “that includes an evalua-  
5           tion” and inserting the following: “that in-  
6           cludes—

7           “(A) an evaluation”;

8           (B) in subparagraph (A) (as so designated),  
9           by adding “and” at the end; and

10          (C) by adding at the end the following:

11          “(B) a summary of the Secretary’s process  
12          for identifying and updating what conditions  
13          constitute Alzheimer’s disease;” and

14          (2) in paragraph (3)(A)(ii), by inserting “and  
15          reduce disparities” before the semicolon at the end.

16          (e) *SUNSET*.—Section 2(h) of the National Alzheimer’s  
17 *Project Act* (42 U.S.C. 11225(h)) is amended by striking

18 “2025” and inserting “2035”.

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
