A BILL

To prohibit Federal funds from being made available for the Justice40 Initiative or for the American Climate Corps.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No American Climate
5 Corps Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. AMERICAN CLIMATE CORPS AND JUSTICE40 INITIA-**
2 **TIVE FUNDING PROHIBITION.**

3 No Federal funds may be used for—

4 (1) the Justice40 Initiative (as described in Ex-
5 ecutive Order 14008 (86 Fed. Reg. 7619, relating to
6 tackling the climate crisis)); or

7 (2) the American Climate Corps (as described
8 in the fact sheet published by the White House on
9 September 20, 2023, relating to the American Cli-
10 mate Corps).
