A BILL

To terminate the authority of the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to provide assistance under the Tenant Resource Network Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Stop Tenant Orga-
5 nizing Promotion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE ASSIST-**
7 **ANCE UNDER THE TENANT RESOURCE NET-**
8 **WORK PROGRAM.**

9 (a) TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY.—Notwithstanding
10 any other provision of law, after the date of the enactment

1 of this Act, the Secretary of Housing and Urban Develop-
2 ment may not carry out, support, or otherwise provide any
3 assistance to the Tenant Resource Network Program au-
4 thorized under section 514(f)(3) of the Department of
5 Veterans Affairs and Housing and Urban Development,
6 and Independent Agencies Appropriations Act, 1998
7 (Public Law 105–65; 111 Stat. 1392).

8 (b) REPEAL OF FUNDING PROVISION FOR THE TEN-
9 ANT RESOURCE NETWORK PROGRAM.—Section 514(f)(3)
10 of the Department of Veterans Affairs and Housing and
11 Urban Development, and Independent Agencies Appro-
12 priations Act, 1998 is repealed.

13 (c) DEFICIT REDUCTION.—Any funds made available
14 under section 514(f)(3) of the Department of Veterans Af-
15 fairs and Housing and Urban Development, and Inde-
16 pendent Agencies Appropriations Act, 1998 that have
17 been allocated for use, but not yet obligated as of the date
18 of the enactment of this Act, for the Tenant Resource Net-
19 work Program shall not be available for obligation or ex-
20 penditure under such Program, but should be covered into
21 the General Fund of the Treasury and should be used only
22 for reducing the budget deficit of the Federal Government.
