## AN ACT

For the relief of Arpita Kurdekar, Girish Kurdekar, and Vandana Kurdekar.

1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

## 1SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ARPITA2KURDEKAR, GIRISH3VANDANA KURDEKAR.

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a) 5 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality Act, Arpita Kurdekar, Girish Kurdekar, and Vandana 6 7 Kurdekar shall each be eligible for issuance of an immi-8 grant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien 9 lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an 10 application for issuance of an immigrant visa under section 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful 11 12 permanent resident.

13 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Arpita Kurdekar, Girish Kurdekar, or Vandana Kurdekar enters the United 14 States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c), 15 16 he or she shall be considered to have entered and remained lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for ad-17 18 justment of status under section 245 of the Immigration 19 and Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of 20this Act.

(c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the application for issuance of an immigrant visa or the application for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.

1 (d) REDUCTION OF IMMIGRANT VISA NUMBER.— 2 Upon the granting of an immigrant visa or permanent residence to Arpita Kurdekar, Girish Kurdekar, and Vandana 3 4 Kurdekar, the Secretary of State shall instruct the proper 5 officer to reduce by 3, during the current or next following fiscal year, the total number of immigrant visas that are 6 7 made available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth 8 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality 9 Act or, if applicable, the total number of immigrant visas 10 that are made available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth under section 202(e) of such Act. 11

12 Preferential IMMIGRATION (e) DENIAL OF 13 TREATMENT FOR CERTAIN RELATIVES.—The natural parents, brothers, and sisters of Arpita Kurdekar, Girish 14 15 Kurdekar, and Vandana Kurdekar shall not, by virtue of such relationship, be accorded any right, privilege, or sta-16 tus under the Immigration and Nationality Act. 17

## 18 SEC. 2. DETERMINATION OF BUDGETARY EFFECTS.

19 The budgetary effects of this Act, for the purpose of 20 complying with the Statutory Pay-As-You-Go Act of 2010, 21 shall be determined by reference to the latest statement 22 titled "Budgetary Effects of PAYGO Legislation" for this 23 Act, submitted for printing in the Congressional Record 24 by the Chairman of the House Budget Committee, pro1 vided that such statement has been submitted prior to the

2 vote on passage.
