A BILL

To amend title 40, United States Code, to establish an expiration date of certain committee resolutions with respect to leases or projects, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LIMITATION ON AUTHORIZATIONS.**

4 Section 3307 of title 40, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(i) EXPIRATION OF COMMITTEE RESOLUTIONS.—

7 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Unless a lease is awarded
8 or a construction, alteration, repair, design, or ac-
9 quisition project is initiated not later than 5 years
10 after the resolution approvals adopted by the Com-
11 mittee on Transportation and Infrastructure of the
12 House of Representatives or the Committee on Envi-
13 ronment and Public Works of the Senate pursuant
14 to subsection (a), such resolutions shall be deemed
15 expired.

16 “(2) APPLICATION.—This subsection shall only
17 apply to resolutions approved after the date of en-
18 actment of this subsection.”.
