4 **PORARY ASSISTANCE FOR STATES WITH AD-**
5 **VANCES.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1202(b)(10) of the Social
7 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1322(b)(10)), as added by section
8 2004 of the Assistance for Unemployed Workers and

1 Struggling Families Act (Public Law 111–5; 123 Stat.
2 443), is amended in subparagraph (A) by striking “De-
3 cember 31, 2010” and inserting “December 31, 2012”.

4 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
5 subsection (a) shall be effective as of December 31, 2010.
