## A BILL

To provide for the conveyance of certain Federal land under the administrative jurisdiction of the Bureau of Land Management in El Dorado County, California, to the Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. LAND CONVEYANCE, BUREAU OF LAND MAN-**  
2 **AGEMENT LAND, EL DORADO COUNTY, CALI-**  
3 **FORNIA, TO SHINGLE SPRINGS BAND OF**  
4 **MIWOK INDIANS.**

5 (a) CONVEYANCE REQUIRED.—At the request of  
6 Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians, the Secretary of  
7 the Interior shall convey to the Shingle Springs Band of  
8 Miwok Indians all right, title, and interest of the United  
9 States in and to the Federal land described in subsection  
10 (b).

11 (b) CONSIDERATION.—As consideration for the con-  
12 veyance under subsection (a), the Shingle Springs Band  
13 of Miwok Indians shall pay to the Secretary an amount  
14 equal to the fair market value of the Federal land con-  
15 veyed.

16 (c) LAND DESCRIPTION.—The Federal land referred  
17 to in subsection (a) is the approximately 40.852 acres of  
18 Federal land under the administrative jurisdiction of the  
19 Bureau of Land Management identified as “Conveyance  
20 boundary” on the map titled “Shingle Springs Land Con-  
21 veyance/Draft” and dated June 7, 2012.
