A BILL

To amend the Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security
Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, and for other
purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CAMPUS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.**

4 (a) SHORT TITLE.—This Act may be cited as the
5 “Campus Safety for Children Act of 2012”.

6 (b) CAMPUS SAFETY REQUIREMENTS.—The Jeanne
7 Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus
8 Crime Statistics Act (section 485(f) of the Higher Edu-
9 cation Act of 1965; 20 U.S.C. 1092(f)) is amended—

1 (1) in subclause (II) of paragraph (1)(F)(i) by
2 inserting “, including such offenses perpetrated
3 against minor children” before the semicolon; and

4 (2) in paragraph (8) by inserting at the end the
5 following new subparagraph:

6 “(D) Each institution of higher education
7 participating in any program under this title,
8 other than a foreign institution of higher edu-
9 cation, may not exempt an employee of such in-
10 stitution from the institution’s campus sexual
11 assault programs described under subparagraph
12 (A)(i).”.

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
