A BILL

To provide for the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to ensure that certain aviation roundtables may appoint technical representatives, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “All Participating in
5 Process Reaching Informed Solutions for Everyone Act”
6 or the “APPRISE Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERFORMANCE-BASED NAVIGATION IMPLEMENTA-**
2 **TION PROCESS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—In carrying out the implementa-
4 tion process for NextGen performance-based navigation
5 (as described in FAA Order JO7100.41A, or any subse-
6 quent similar order), the Administrator of the Federal
7 Aviation Administration shall ensure that any covered
8 aviation roundtable or community highly impacted by
9 aviation noise may appoint a technical representative or
10 consultant to participate as member of the core working
11 group or the full working group of such process on the
12 same terms and conditions as a representative of the in-
13 dustry, an airport, or a participating proponent of a proce-
14 dure.

15 (b) COVERED AVIATION ROUNDTABLE DEFINED.—
16 The term “covered aviation roundtable” means an aviation
17 roundtable—

18 (1) that is the actual or de facto proponent of
19 a proposed new or modified performance-based navi-
20 gation flight procedure; or

21 (2) for which the modified procedure path to be
22 implemented in the process described in subsection
23 (a) is within 5 miles of the jurisdictional area of the
24 aviation roundtable.

25 (c) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 180 days
26 after the date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator

1 shall submit to the Committee on Transportation and In-
2 frastructure of the House of Representatives and the Com-
3 mittee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the
4 Senate a report on the progress made toward imple-
5 menting the requirements under subsection (a).

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
