## A BILL

To provide that the labeling of certain single ingredient foods is not required to include an added sugars declaration.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may cited as the “Natural Sugar Labeling  
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. LABELING OF CERTAIN SINGLE INGREDIENT**  
7 **FOODS.**

8 The food labeling requirements under section 403(q)  
9 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act (21 U.S.C.  
10 343(q)) shall not require that the nutrition facts label of

1 any single ingredient sugar, honey, agave, and syrup, in-  
2 cluding maple syrup, that is packaged and offered for sale  
3 as a single ingredient food bear the declaration “Includes  
4 Xg Added Sugars”.
