Mr. TURNER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To prohibit covered entities from requiring consumers to solely use digital monthly statements, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Against
5 Paperless and Electronic Requirements Act” or the
6 “PAPER Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Each covered entity shall offer
9 each consumer of such entity the option of receiving paper
10 copies of their monthly statements.

1 (b) PROHIBITION.—A covered entity may not condi-
2 tion the use of any services offered by such entity on the
3 sole use of digital monthly statements by a consumer.

4 (c) DEFINITIONS.—

5 (1) DEPOSITORY INSTITUTION.—The term “de-
6 pository institution” has the meaning given the term
7 in section 3 of the Federal Deposit Act.

8 (2) CREDIT UNION.—The term “credit union”
9 has the meaning given the term in section 101 of the
10 Federal Credit Union Act.

11 (3) COVERED ENTITY.—The term “covered en-
12 tity” means a depository institution or a credit
13 union.
