A BILL

To exempt commercial truck drivers from Canada or Mexico who are seeking to temporarily enter the United States for business through a land port of entry from any COVID–19 vaccination requirement.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLES.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Terminating Reckless
5 and Unnecessary Checks Known to Erode Regular Ship-
6 ping Act” or the “TRUCKERS Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FROM COVID-19 VACCINATION RE-**
2 **QUIREMENT.**

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
4 retary of Homeland Security may not impose any COVID-
5 19 vaccination requirement on any commercial truck driv-
6 er who is a national of Canada or of Mexico and is seeking
7 to temporarily enter the United States for business
8 through a land port of entry.
