A BILL

To amend the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act to remove the exclusion of certain small business concerns from the disadvantaged business enterprise program, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Small Business Con-
5 tracting Fairness Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISES.**

2 Section 11101(e)(2)(A) of the Infrastructure Invest-
3 ment and Jobs Act (Public Law 117–58; 135 Stat. 449)
4 is amended to read as follows:

5 “(A) ‘SMALL BUSINESS CONCERN’.—The
6 term ‘small business concern’ means a small
7 business concern (as the term is used in section
8 3 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
9 632)).”.
