## A BILL

To prohibit the establishment of a Civilian Climate Corps, American Climate Corps, or any similar program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Cancelling Climate  
5 Crusaders Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING A CIVILIAN CLIMATE CORPS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-  
8 sion of law or any executive action, the Corporation for  
9 National and Community Service (in this Act referred to  
10 as the “Corporation”) shall not establish a Civilian Cli-

1 mate Corps, American Climate Corps, or any similar pro-  
2 gram as described in Executive Order 14008 (86 Fed.  
3 Reg. 7619, relating to tackling the climate crisis).

4 (b) PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES.—The Corporation shall  
5 not establish any program, direct any entity to create such  
6 a program, or provide guidance to any partnering entity  
7 to engage in any of the following activities:

8 (1) Promoting environmental justice.

9 (2) Restoring roads to natural conditions.

10 (3) Remediating and reclaiming devastated  
11 lands left by extractive industries.

12 (4) Organizing community-based resiliency coa-  
13 litions and working groups.

14 (5) Developing farm to institution distribution  
15 models.

16 (6) Conducting energy audits.

17 (7) Advising citizens on climate policy.

18 (8) Educating students through school and  
19 youth programs.

20 (9) Improving pollution monitoring.
