A BILL

To require States to report information on Medicaid payments to abortion providers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, 2

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Taxpayer Conscience
- Protection Act of 2019". 5

SEC. 2. REQUIRED REPORTING OF MEDICAID PAYMENTS 6 7

TO ABORTION PROVIDERS.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 60 days after the 9 end of the first fiscal year ending after the date of the enactment of this Act and each fiscal year thereafter, each
 State that makes a Medicaid payment from Federal funds
 during the fiscal year for any items or services furnished
 by an abortion provider shall—

5 (1) submit to the Secretary a report on all such6 payments; and

7 (2) publish the report on a public internet8 website of the State.

9 (b) REPORT DESCRIBED.—The report under sub-10 section (a) shall, with respect to a State that makes a 11 Medicaid payment from Federal funds during the fiscal 12 year for any items or services furnished by an abortion 13 provider, include the following:

- 14 (1) With respect to each such payment, each of15 the following:
- 16 (A) A specification of the amount of the17 payment.
- (B) A specification of the purposes forwhich the payment was made.

20 (C) A comparison of the amount of the
21 payment with the amount of any such payment
22 to the provider involved in any prior fiscal year.
23 (2) A specification of the number of abortions
24 performed during the fiscal year by the provider in-

1	volved and the gestational age with respect to each
2	such abortion.

3 (c) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 90 days
4 after the end of each fiscal year described in subsection
5 (a), the Secretary shall submit to the Committee on En6 ergy and Commerce of the House of Representatives and
7 to the Committee on Finance of the Senate, and publish
8 on a public internet website of the Department of Health
9 and Human Services, a report that—

10 (1) contains the reports submitted pursuant to11 subsection (a) for the fiscal year; and

12 (2) includes a summary of the reports.

13 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

14 (1) ABORTION PROVIDER.—The term "abortion
15 provider" means an entity that—

16 (A) performs (or refers an individual for)17 an abortion; or

(B) controls, is controlled by, or is under
common control with, an entity described in
subparagraph (A).

(2) MEDICAID PAYMENT FROM FEDERAL
FUNDS.—The term "Medicaid payment from Federal funds" means a payment for which there is
Federal financial participation under title XIX of
the Social Security Act.

1	(3) Secretary.—The term "Secretary" means
2	the Secretary of Health and Human Services.
3	(4) STATE.—The term "State" has the mean-
4	ing given the term for purposes of title XIX of the
5	Social Security Act.
6	(e) Conforming Amendments to Social Secu-
7	RITY ACT.—Section 1902(a) of the Social Security Act
8	(42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended—
9	(1) by striking "and" at the end of paragraph
10	(85);
11	(2) by striking the period at the end of para-
12	graph (86) and inserting "; and"; and
13	(3) by inserting after paragraph (86) the fol-
14	lowing:
15	"(87) provide for the submission of reports in
16	accordance with section 2 of the Taxpayer Con-
17	science Protection Act of 2019.".
