A BILL

To express the sense of Congress regarding State choice
in the observation of daylight saving time.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Don’t Mess with Ari-
5 zona Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING STATE CHOICE**

7 **IN OBSERVATION OF DAYLIGHT SAVING**
8 **TIME.**

9 It is the sense of Congress that Arizona, and any
10 other State that has exempted itself from the provisions

1 of section 3(a) of the Uniform Time Act of 1966 (15
2 U.S.C. 260a(a)), as in effect on March 15, 2022, should
3 be able to—

4 (1) continue to observe permanent standard
5 time; and

6 (2) elect to observe daylight saving time in the
7 future.
