Mr. MOULTON (for himself, Mr. MELJER, Mr. AUCHINCLOSS, and Mr. GALLAGHER) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To authorize the provision of humanitarian assistance to
Ukraine.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Yachts for Ukraine
5 Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE HUMANITARIAN ASSIST-**
7 **ANCE TO UKRAINE.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
9 sion of law, the President is authorized to take such ac-
10 tions as may be necessary to use the amounts described

1 in subsection (b) to provide humanitarian assistance to
2 Ukraine.

3 (b) AMOUNTS DESCRIBED.—The amounts described
4 in this subsection are the following:

5 (1) All monetary assets of individuals described
6 in subsection (c) if such assets are subject to United
7 States jurisdiction and control by reason of the im-
8 position of sanctions under any provision of United
9 States law.

10 (2) All amounts derived from the liquidation or
11 sales of other assets of individuals described in sub-
12 section (c) if such assets are subject to United
13 States jurisdiction and control by reason of the im-
14 position of sanctions under any provision of United
15 States law.

16 (c) INDIVIDUALS DESCRIBED.—The individuals de-
17 scribed in this subsection are the following:

18 (1) Individuals who are oligarchs of the Russian
19 Federation, as determined by the President.

20 (2) Individuals who are senior foreign political
21 figures of the Russian Federation.

22 (d) SENIOR FOREIGN POLITICAL FIGURE DE-
23 FINED.—In subsection (c)(2), the term “senior foreign po-

- 1 litical figure” has the meaning given that term in section
- 2 1010.605 of title 31, Code of Federal Regulations.
