A BILL

To direct the Secretary of State to submit to Congress a report on funding provided by the United States to the United Nations Relief and Works Agency for Palestinian Refugees in the Near East (UNRWA), and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Uncovering UNRWA’s
5 Terrorist Crimes Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORT.**

2 Not later than 90 days after the date of the enact-
3 ment of this Act, the Secretary of State shall submit to
4 Congress a report that—

5 (1) identifies the total amounts of funding pro-
6 vided by the United States to the United Nations
7 Relief and Works Agency for Palestinian Refugees
8 in the Near East (UNRWA) during fiscal years
9 2020 through 2024, including an identification of
10 such amounts disaggregated by calendar month of
11 such fiscal years; and

12 (2) a description of how such funds were spent.

13 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITION.**

14 Effective beginning on the date of the enactment of
15 this Act, no Federal funds may be used to provide funding,
16 directly or indirectly, to UNRWA.
