A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to eliminate any August recess for the House of Representatives until the House has approved all annual appropriation bills for the next fiscal year.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Budget No Recess
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. HOUSE APPROVAL OF REGULAR APPROPRIATION**

3 Section 309 of the Congressional Budget Act of 1974
4 (2 U.S.C. 640) is amended by inserting “or August” after
5 “July”.

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
