## A BILL

To repeal certain formula grants under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 and use such funds to award block grants to States.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Building Lasting Op-  
5 portunities for Community K–12 Act” or the “BLOCK  
6 Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. BLOCK GRANTS TO STATES.**

8 Beginning with fiscal year 2025, and each succeeding  
9 fiscal year thereafter, the Secretary of Education shall  
10 award block grants to each State in an amount that the

1 State received under the provisions listed in section 3 for  
2 fiscal year 2024.

3 **SEC. 3. REPEAL OF CERTAIN FORMULA GRANTS UNDER**  
4 **THE ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDU-**  
5 **CATION ACT OF 1965.**

6 On October 1, 2024, the following provisions of the  
7 Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (20  
8 U.S.C. 6301 et seq.) shall be repealed:

9 (1) Grants to local educational agencies under  
10 part A of title I (20 U.S.C. 6311 et seq.).

11 (2) State Assessment Grants under part B of  
12 title I (20 U.S.C. 6361 et seq.).

13 (3) Migrant Education under part C of title I  
14 (20 U.S.C. 6391 et seq.).

15 (4) Neglected and Delinquent under part D of  
16 title I (20 U.S.C. 6421 et seq.).

17 (5) Supporting Effective Instruction State  
18 Grants under part A of title II (20 U.S.C. 6611 et  
19 seq.).

20 (6) English Language Acquisition under part A  
21 of title III (20 U.S.C. 6811 et seq.).

22 (7) Student Support and Academic Enrichment  
23 Grants under part A of title IV (20 U.S.C. 7111 et  
24 seq.).

1           (8) The 21st Century Learning Centers under  
2 part B of title IV (20 U.S.C. 7171 et seq.).

3           (9) Rural Education under part B of title V (20  
4 U.S.C. 7341 et seq.).

5           (10) Indian Education Formula Grants to  
6 Local Educational Agencies under subpart 1 of part  
7 A of title VI (20 U.S.C. 7421 et seq.).
