AN ACT

- To direct the Secretary of Energy to establish a program to provide financial assistance to graduate students and postdoctoral researchers pursuing certain courses of study relating to cybersecurity and energy infrastructure.
 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Energy Cybersecurity3 University Leadership Act of 2022".

4 SEC. 2. ENERGY CYBERSECURITY UNIVERSITY LEADER-5 SHIP PROGRAM.

6 (a) FINDINGS.—Congress finds the following:

7 (1) Addressing cybersecurity vulnerabilities in
8 energy-related critical infrastructure after an intru9 sion occurs is inefficient, ineffective, and costly.

10 (2) Integrating cybersecurity considerations 11 into the research, design, and development of energy 12 infrastructure represents a cost-effective approach to 13 enhancing the security, resilience, and reliability of 14 the electric grid, oil and natural gas pipelines, and 15 other energy distribution, transmission, and genera-16 tion systems.

17 (3) Successfully employing the approach out18 lined in paragraph (2) as a guiding principle for the
19 Department's energy infrastructure activities will re20 quire a diverse, inclusive, and highly skilled work21 force which possesses energy-specific cybersecurity
22 expertise and familiarity with associated research,
23 development, and demonstration needs.

(4) A dedicated science scholarship program at
the Department for graduate students and
postdoctoral researchers studying energy-specific cy-

3	(b) Program.—
4	(1) ESTABLISHMENT.—The Secretary of En-
5	ergy shall establish an Energy Cybersecurity Univer-
6	sity Leadership Program (referred to in this section
7	as the "Program") to carry out the activities de-
8	scribed in paragraph (2).
9	(2) PROGRAM ACTIVITIES.—The Secretary
10	shall—
11	(A) provide financial assistance, on a com-
12	petitive basis, for scholarships, fellowships, and
13	research and development projects at institu-
14	tions of higher education to support graduate
15	students and postdoctoral researchers pursuing
16	a course of study that integrates cybersecurity
17	competencies within disciplines associated with
18	energy infrastructure needs;
19	(B) provide graduate students and
20	postdoctoral researchers supported under the
21	Program with research traineeship experiences
22	at National Laboratories and utilities; and
23	(C) conduct outreach to historically Black
24	colleges and universities, Tribal Colleges or
25	Universities, and minority-serving institutions.

1 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date 2 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary shall submit 3 to the Committee on Science, Space, and Technology of 4 the House of Representatives and the Committee on En-5 ergy and Natural Resources of the Senate a report on the 6 development and implementation of the Program.

7 (d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

8 (1) DEPARTMENT.—The term "Department"
9 means the Department of Energy.

10 (2) HISTORICALLY BLACK COLLEGE AND UNI11 VERSITY.—The term "historically Black college and
12 university" has the meaning given the term "part B
13 institution" in section 322 of the Higher Education
14 Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1061).

(3) INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.—The
term "institution of higher education" has the
meaning given such term in section 101(a) of the
Higher Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1001(a)).

(4) MINORITY-SERVING INSTITUTION.—The
term "minority-serving institution" means an eligible institution under section 371(a) of the Higher
Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1067q(a)).

23 (5) NATIONAL LABORATORY.—The term "Na24 tional Laboratory" has the meaning given such term

in section 2 of the Energy Policy Act of 2005 (42
 U.S.C. 15801).
 (6) TRIBAL COLLEGE OR UNIVERSITY.—The
 term "Tribal College or University" has the meaning
 given such term in section 316(b) of the Higher
 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 1059c(b)).
