A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Commerce, acting through the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information, to conduct a study of the national security risks posed by consumer routers, modems, and devices that combine a modem and router, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Removing Our Unse-
5 cure Technologies to Ensure Reliability and Security Act”
6 or the “ROUTERS Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. STUDY OF NATIONAL SECURITY RISKS POSED BY**
8 **CERTAIN ROUTERS AND MODEMS.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary shall conduct a
10 study of the national security risks posed by consumer
11 routers, modems, and devices that combine a modem and
12 router that are designed, developed, manufactured, or sup-
13 plied by persons owned by, controlled by, or subject to the
14 influence of a covered country.

15 (b) REPORT TO CONGRESS.—Not later than 1 year
16 after the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
17 shall submit to the Committee on Energy and Commerce
18 of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
19 Commerce, Science, and Transportation of the Senate a
20 report on the results of the study conducted under sub-
21 section (a).

22 (c) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

23 (1) COVERED COUNTRY.—The term “covered
24 country” means a country specified in section
25 4872(d)(2) of title 10, United States Code.

1 (2) SECRETARY.—The term “Secretary” means
2 the Secretary of Commerce, acting through the As-
3 sistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications
4 and Information.
