3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "San Joaquin Valley

5 Transportation Enhancement Act of 2011".

6 SEC. 2. FUNDING FOR CALIFORNIA STATE ROUTE 99.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi8 sion of law, including the terms of any grant agreement,

covered Federal funding made available to the State of
 California may be used by that State for any project or
 activity to improve or maintain California State Route 99
 between the cities of Sacramento and Bakersfield.

5 (b) COVERED FEDERAL FUNDING DEFINED.—In
6 this section, the term "covered Federal funding" means
7 any Federal funding made available to a State as a result
8 of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009
9 (Public Law 111–5) for the purpose of developing high10 speed rail service.

(c) APPLICABILITY.—This section shall apply to all
covered Federal funding made available to the State of
California after the date of enactment of the American
Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (Public Law 111–
5).
