13	and Technical Education Act of 2006 (20 U.S.C. 2302).".
14	(b) Small Business Development Centers.—
15	Section 21(c)(3) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.
16	648(c)(1)) is amended—
17	(1) in subparagraph (T), by striking "and" at
18	the end;
19	(2) in clause (v) of the first subparagraph (U)
20	(relating to succession planning), by striking the pe-
21	riod at the end and inserting a semicolon;
22	(3) in second subparagraph (U) (relating to
23	training on domestic and international intellectual
24	property protections)—

17	(3) by adding at the end the following new
