A BILL

To direct the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to establish a separate, unique North American Industry Classification System code for health care facility janitorial services, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Health Care Facility
5 Janitorial Services Classification and Cap Enhancement
6 Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. SEPARATE NAICS CODE FOR HEALTH CARE FACIL-**
2 **ITY JANITORIAL SERVICES.**

3 (a) NAICS CODE.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Director of the Office
5 of Management and Budget shall update the North Amer-
6 ican Industry Classification System (in this section re-
7 ferred to as “NAICS”) to establish a separate, unique
8 code for the health care facility janitorial services indus-
9 try.

10 (b) SIZE STANDARD.—Not later than 90 days after
11 the date on which an NAICS code is established under
12 subsection (a), the Administrator of the Small Business
13 Administration shall establish a size standard under sec-
14 tion 3(a) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 632(a))
15 for an entity assigned such NAICS code. Such size stand-
16 ard may not be more than double the size standard for
17 an entity assigned NAICS code 561720 (relating to jani-
18 torial services) on the date of enactment of this Act.

19 (c) HEALTH CARE FACILITY JANITORIAL SERVICES
20 INDUSTRY DEFINED.—In this section, the term “health
21 care facility janitorial services industry” means an indus-
22 try that comprises entities primarily engaged in cleaning
23 interiors of health care facilities, including hospitals, out-
24 patient facilities, clinical laboratories, or other medical fa-
25 cilities.
