A BILL

To improve the infant formula supply chain, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY SUSPENSION OF TARIFFS.**

4 During the 90-day period beginning on the date of
5 enactment of this Act, and notwithstanding any other pro-
6 vision of law, no duty shall be imposed with respect to
7 the importation of any infant formula product.

1 **SEC. 2. STUDY ON FEASIBILITY OF INFANT FORMULA DIS-**
2 **TRIBUTION CENTERS REMAINING OPEN FOR**
3 **24 HOURS A DAY.**

4 The Comptroller General of the United States shall—

5 (1) study the feasibility of food infant formula
6 distribution centers remaining open for 24 hours a
7 day and any corresponding impacts to supply chains,
8 including to determine whether keeping such centers
9 open 24 hours a day would contribute to increasing
10 the flow of goods and products to store shelves and
11 final points of sale; and

12 (2) not later 30 days after the date of enact-
13 ment of this Act, complete such study and submit to
14 the Congress a report on the results of such study.
