## A BILL

For the relief of Adrian Rodriguez.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. COMPENSATION OF ADRIAN RODRIGUEZ.
- 4 (a) Payment.—The Secretary of the Treasury shall
- 5 pay, out of funds not otherwise appropriated, an appro-
- 6 priate amount to compensate Adrian Rodriguez for costs
- 7 related to and damages arising from his arrest, prosecu-
- 8 tion, and incarceration in Mexico in 2003 as described in
- 9 Claim No. 05-370C filed in the United States Court of
- 10 Federal Claims.
- 11 (b) Satisfaction of Claims.—The payment under
- 12 subsection (a) shall be in full satisfaction of all claims of

- 1 Adrian Rodriguez against the United States in connection
- 2 with the matter described in such subsection.
- 3 (c) NO INFERENCE OF LIABILITY.—Nothing in this
- 4 Act shall be construed as an inference of liability on the
- 5 part of the United States.
- 6 SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEYS' AND AGENTS' FEES.
- 7 (a) IN GENERAL.—It shall be unlawful for an amount
- 8 exceeding 10 percent of the amount paid pursuant to sec-
- 9 tion 1 to be paid to, or received by, any agent or attorney
- 10 for any service rendered in connection with the payment
- 11 under this Act.
- 12 (b) Enforcement.—Any person who violates sub-
- 13 section (a) shall be guilty of an infraction and shall be
- 14 fined under title 18, United States Code.
