A BILL

To direct the Federal Trade Commission to revise the regulations regarding the "do-not-call" registry to prohibit politically-oriented recorded message telephone calls to telephone numbers listed on that registry.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Robo Calls Off Phones
- 5 Act" or the "Robo COP Act".

1	SEC. 2. POLITICALLY-ORIENTED RECORDED MESSAGE
2	PHONE CALLS PROHIBITED.
3	(a) Prohibited.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
4	sion of law, the Federal Trade Commission shall, not later
5	than 180 days after the date of enactment of this Act,
6	revise the "do-not-call" registry provisions of the Tele-
7	marketing Sales Rule (16 C.F.R. 310.1 et seq.) to prohibit
8	politically-oriented recorded message telephone calls to
9	telephone numbers listed on that registry.
10	(b) Definition of Politically-Oriented Re-
11	CORDED MESSAGE CALLS.—For purposes of this section,
12	the term "politically-oriented recorded message telephone
13	call" means any outbound telephone call—
14	(1) in which a person is not available to speak
15	with the person answering the call, and the call in-
16	stead plays a recorded message; and
17	(2)(A) the purpose of which is to promote, ad-
18	vertise, campaign, or solicit donations, for or against
19	any political candidate or regarding any political
20	issue; or
21	(B) uses in the recorded message any political
22	candidate's name.
