SECTION 1. CHIEF STANDING BEAR NATIONAL HISTORIC TRAIL FEASIBILITY STUDY.

3 Section 5(c) of the National Trails System Act (16
4 U.S.C. 1244(c)) is amended by adding at the end the fol5 lowing:

6 "(xx) CHIEF STANDING BEAR NATIONAL HIS-7 TORIC TRAIL.—The Chief Standing Bear Trail, ex-8 tending approximately 550 miles from Niobrara, Ne-9 braska, to Ponca City, Oklahoma, which follows the 10 route taken by Chief Standing Bear and the Ponca 11 people during Federal Indian removal, and approxi-12 mately 550 miles from Ponca City, Oklahoma, 13 through Omaha, Nebraska, to Niobrara, Nebraska, 14 which follows the return route taken by Chief Stand-15 ing Bear and the Ponca people.".
