# A BILL

To amend the Recreation and Public Purposes Act to authorize sales and leases of certain Federal land to federally recognized Indian Tribes, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2   *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3   **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Recreation and Public  
5   Purposes Tribal Parity Act”.

6   **SEC. 2. SALE OR LEASE OF LAND TO FEDERALLY RECOG-**  
7                      **NIZED INDIAN TRIBES UNDER THE RECRE-**  
8                      **ATION AND PUBLIC PURPOSES ACT.**

9       (a)   **APPLICATION; ACREAGE LIMITATIONS.**—The  
10   first section of the Act of June 14, 1926 (commonly  
11   known as the “Recreation and Public Purposes Act”) (44  
12   Stat. 741, chapter 578; 68 Stat. 174, chapter 263; 43  
13   U.S.C. 869), is amended—

14                  (1) in subsection (a)—

15                      (A) in the first sentence—

16                          (i) by inserting “federally recognized  
17   Indian Tribe,” before “Territory,”; and  
18                          (ii) by inserting “Tribal,” before  
19   “Territorial,”; and

20                      (B) in the second sentence, by inserting “,  
21   Tribal,” before “or local authority”;

22                  (2) in subsection (b)—

23                      (A) by striking “(i) For recreational” and  
24   inserting the following:

25                      “(1) For recreational”;

1                             (B) by striking “(ii) For public purposes”  
2                             and inserting the following:

3                             “(2) For public purposes”;

4                             (C) in paragraph (1) (as so designated), by  
5                             adding at the end the following:

6                             “(D) To any federally recognized Indian  
7                             Tribe, 6,400 acres.”; and

8                             (D) in paragraph (2) (as so designated),  
9                             by adding at the end the following:

10                             “(D) To any federally recognized Indian  
11                             Tribe, 640 acres.”; and

12                             (3) in subsection (c)—

13                             (A) in the second sentence, by striking  
14                             “States and counties and to State and Federal”  
15                             and inserting “States, federally recognized In-  
16                             dian Tribes, and counties and to State, Tribal,  
17                             Territorial, and Federal”; and

18                             (B) in the last sentence, by striking “, ex-  
19                             cept for a use authorized under the Act of June  
20                             1, 1938 (52 Stat. 609; 43 U.S.C., sec. 682a),  
21                             as amended”.

22                             (b) CONVEYANCE.—Section 2 of the Act of June 14,  
23                             1926 (commonly known as the “Recreation and Public  
24                             Purposes Act”) (44 Stat. 741, chapter 578; 43 U.S.C.  
25                             869–1), is amended—

- 1                   (1) by inserting “, federally recognized Indian  
2       Tribe” before “, Territory” each place it appears;  
3                   (2) by inserting “Tribal,” before “Territorial,”  
4       each place it appears; and  
5                   (3) by inserting “federally recognized Indian  
6       Tribe or” before “municipal corporation” each place  
7       it appears.
