## A BILL

To amend the Consolidated Farm and Rural Development Act to eliminate a requirement that certain individuals be related by blood or marriage to be eligible for farm loans as a qualified beginning farmer or rancher, and for other purposes.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Future Farmers and  
5 Ranchers of Tomorrow Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR FARM LOANS AS A QUALIFIED BE-**  
2 **GINNING FARMER OR RANCHER.**

3 Section 343(a)(11) of the Consolidated Farm and  
4 Rural Development Act (7 U.S.C. 1991(a)(11)) is amend-  
5 ed by striking subparagraph (C) and redesignating sub-  
6 paragraphs (D) through (G) as subparagraphs (C)  
7 through (F), respectively.
