A BILL

To require the Director of the Federal Housing Finance Agency to require each enterprise to include a military service question on the form known as the Uniform Residential Loan Application above the signature line of such application, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MILITARY SERVICE QUESTION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subpart A of part 2 of subtitle
5 A of title 13 of the Housing and Community Development
6 Act of 1992 (12 U.S.C. 4541 et seq.) is amended by add-
7 ing at the end the following:

1 **“SEC. 1329. UNIFORM RESIDENTIAL LOAN APPLICATION.**

2 “The Director shall, not later than 6 months after
3 the date of the enactment of this section, require each en-
4 terprise to—

5 “(1) include a military service question on the
6 form known as the Uniform Residential Loan Appli-
7 cation; and

8 “(2) position such question above the signature
9 line of the Uniform Residential Loan Application.”.

10 (b) RULEMAKING.—The Director of the Federal
11 Housing Finance Agency shall, not later than 6 months
12 after the date of the enactment of this section, issue a
13 rule to carry out the amendment made by this section.

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
