A BILL

To prohibit any head of a Federal agency or department from leasing certain Federal property to abortion providing organizations, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Life on
5 Federal Lands Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. RESTRICTION ON LEASE OF FEDERAL PROPERTY.**

2 (a) IN GENERAL.—The head of a Federal agency or
3 department may not lease Federal property to an abortion
4 providing organization.

5 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

6 (1) ABORTION PROVIDING ORGANIZATION.—

7 The term “abortion providing organization”
8 means—

9 (A) any organization that provides abor-
10 tion services; and

11 (B) any organization that wholly or par-
12 tially owns, is a parent company to, or is a sub-
13 sidiary of an organization described in subpara-
14 graph (A).

15 (2) FEDERAL PROPERTY.—The term “Federal
16 property” means any building, land, or other real
17 property owned, leased, or occupied by any depart-
18 ment, agency, or instrumentality of the United
19 States (including the Department of Defense and
20 the United States Postal Service), or any other in-
21 strumentality wholly owned by the United States, or
22 by any department or agency of the District of Co-
23 lumbia or any territory or possession of the United
24 States.
